didate for alderman in Ward 5 was held in this city last Wednesday the 14th of this month and the vote for the different candidates was as follows: Bubier (Republican) 1857; Connery (Democrat) 2408; Goldthwait (Social Democratic Nomination Paper) 118: Goodwin (Socialist Labor Party) 83. The total vote of the city is nearly 11,000 and the total vote cast on Tuesday was 4461. The only par ties to hold rallies were the Social Democratic and Socialist Labor. The Social Democrats held one outdoor rally and two rallies in their halls which were only attended by Social ists. The S. L. P. held street corner rallies nearly every evening of the last week of the campaign and the night before election they held three in the centre of the city. 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
