Another effect of the eight hour or shorter workday move-ment, is the impetus it gives to the concentration and develop-ment of industry. The silk industry will undoubtedly energe from the Paterson strike in a more centralized or trustified form. Should the striklers gain the shorter workday, the effect will be greater in that direction. Larger capital, more improved ma-chinery, more "scientific management" may loxically be expected to follow the great struggle. That in turn will ne-essitate closer organization and more battles later on for the slaves. The strug-gle for a shorter workday promotes the development of capital-ism, as well as the unity of the working class. Far from being a fallacy, should the workers fail to make that struggle, their eman-cipation would be impossible.
